

WHAT IS THE CLASSICAL CONSORTIUM?

C.C. is a one-day-a-week, comprehensive, academic program that follows a classical method in both the subjects taught and how those subjects are taught. Students are in C.C. classes on Mondays and are responsible to accomplish homework from those classes during the week under their parents' supervision. C.C. serves students in third through twelfth grades.

SCHEDULE AND COURSES

The Classical Consortium meets every Monday from August 19th until May 19th except holidays. Students participate in chapel each Monday at 8:00am and are in class from 8:20am until 3:45pm. The courses taught at each level are:

TUITION

Tuition for C.C. Grammar students is \$1,350/year, Logic students is \$1,450/year and Rhetoric 1-3 students is \$1,650/year and \$2,000/year for R4 students who take all five available classes or \$450/class. Tuition may be paid in monthly installments. Books must be purchased separately. A comprehensive booklist is provided by C.C.

WHAT IS H.E.A.R.T.?

H.E.A.R.T. (Homeschool Enrichment Achieved Respectfully Together) is a ninemonth, weekly program for homeschooled children from kindergarten through 8th grade that supplements the teaching they receive at home through qualified instruction in the areas of art, science, Spanish, and physical education. In addition, students may choose between music, drama, and a bible study. Younger students are exposed to a wide variety of subjects during month-long unit studies taught by parent volunteers. Older students are able to take classes in sign language, speech/apologetics, leadership, life skills, LEGO® machines, photography, project club, art, crocheting, and strategic games.

SCHEDULE

H.E.A.R.T. meets every Thursday from September 5th until May 22nd except holidays. Students attend class from 8:30am to 3:15pm.

LOCATION

Classes are held at The Village Church of Barrington at 1600 East Main Street in Barrington, IL.

TUITION AND SERVICE COMMITMENT

Yearly tuition for H.E.A.R.T. students in kindergarten through third grades is \$855. Students in fourth through eighth grades are able join us for the morning (\$540/year), afternoon (\$360/year) or all day (\$900/year). There are additional fees associated with some classes. Tuition may be paid in equal monthly installments. In addition, parents of kindergarten through third grade students must volunteer roughly 15 hours per student enrolled. Parents of fourth through eighth grade must volunteer roughly 7 hours per enrolled student. When parents are not volunteering they are <u>not</u> required to be on site.

ATTENTION HOME SCHOOLERS

Does your child already play a wind or percussion instrument? Have you had good intentions to add music to your curriculum? Perhaps you cannot afford private music lessons. A very inexpensive way to help your child learn, grow, and experience the rush after a well-performed concert, is to make the West Suburban Home School Band a part of their school week. Students make new friends, are accountable to someone other than mom or dad, and strive for their personal best as part of a wholesome group working towards a common goal.

Membership has grown from 46 students/26 families in 2001, to about 200 students/100 families in 2012-2013. Students range in age from 7 to 19. There are four band levels to accommodate those with no musical training whatsoever to those with advanced experience and abilities. We also accept both experienced and beginner parents. Auditions are required for all levels but Cadets.

Those who wish to audition for Concert Junior, Concert Senior or Symphonic level as part of the WSHSB Annual Summer Chair Competition must submit an audition video by the August deadline. AUDITIONING FOR A PARTICULAR BAND DOES NOT GUARANTEE ACCEPTANCE IN THAT BAND. There may also be limits in instrument sections within each band level. The Concert Season roster is set by the end of August. JOIN ANYTIME - Once the audition video deadline has past you are still able to join by submitting an audition video with the following understanding. You will be placed in the band where we feel you fit best and you will be at the end of the roster for your instrument. Those who do not submit an audition video will not receive music and will not be considered a member of the band.

We also welcome musicians with a minimum of 1-year experience on their instrument, to **join** us for summer marching which begins with Marching Camp in mid-June. See website for details
